Initial Information Checklist

For Potential Solar Install

I understand that alternate sources of power (such a solar panels) that are connected to the
grid are a safety hazard to utility line workers. Therefore my solar system will require an external
disconnect switch designed to prevent back-feeding clearly visible & marked, within 10' of the Utility
Meter.
I understand that all solar panels will quit working if utility power goes off. Solar panels are not
a back-up power source during an outage, unless batteries are installed.
I understand that I will be responsible for all maintenance & needed repairs to any solar equipment installed, in order to ensure a safe grid connection.
I understand that each solar system will only provide generated power to 1 Utility Billed meter
provided by LEC. Lamar Electric does not require a 2nd meter base for production monitoring; but if the member wants one, they will be responsible for providing that meter.
I understand that most solar systems will likely reduce my electric bill by about 30%.
I understand that I will be billed for all kWh consumed that are provided by the utility, day or night.
I understand that an oversized solar system will usually result in excess power going back or
the grid, and may result in payments to the finance company that are longer than the life of the solar equipment.
